## **Qualifications of Directors**

6.01 The following individuals, in addition to those specified in the Act and the regulations, shall not be eligible to be elected or entitled to remain directors of the Co-operative:

- a. Individuals having an account with the Co-operative which is over three months in arrears:
- b. Individual who have not transacted at least \$5,000 in business with the Co-operative during the preceding fiscal year;
- c. Employees of the Co-operative;
- d. No director shall be eligible for re-election after serving three consecutive terms of 3 years, until he has been out of office for at least one year;
- e. Individuals who have not been members of the Co-operative for at least two years immediately preceding election;
- f. Individuals under the age of eighteen;
- g. An unsatisfactory criminal record check according to Saskatchewan Liquor and Gaming Authority (SLGA); or
- h. An individual who has declared bankruptcy.
- i. A Director absent without a bona fide reason for three consecutive regular board meetings, as determined by the Board President; or
- j. A Director found in contravention of the Co-operative's Board of Directors Code of Conduct and Ethics Policy as determined by the Riverbend Co-operative Board Code of Conduct & Ethics Committee

## **Director Duties and Powers**

The directors are responsible for establishing policies and directing the affairs of the co-operative to meet the goals and objectives of the members.
